

REGULATION XI - STATE AIRBORNE TOXIC CONTROL MEASURES

(Adopted March 7, 2005, Amended April 4, 2005; October 1, 2007)

Rule 11.1

A. GENERAL

A.1 Purpose: The purpose of this Rule is to incorporate California State Airborne Toxic Control Measures adopted by the California Air Resources Board (ATCM) into the Rules and Regulations of the Feather River Air Quality Management District, pursuant to the authority of Health and Safety Code Section 39666.

A.2 Applicability: The provisions of this Rule shall apply to the all sources of airborne toxics within the Feather River Air Quality Management District (FRAQMD).

A.3 Exemptions: Specific exemptions to this Rule shall be as provided within each ATCM incorporated into this Rule under Section C.

A.4 Effective Dates: This Rule and any amendment thereto are, and shall be, effective on the date of its adoption by the Feather River Air Quality Management District.
