

IMPERIAL COUNTY AIR POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT

RULE 307 - LIVESTOCK FEED YARD FEES

(Revised 1/11/94; 1/16/2001; 8/10/04; 9/19/05)

Every person using or operating a livestock feed yard provided for under Rule 420 shall pay an annual certificate fee. Beginning in the year 2005, the annual certificate fee shall increase at the rate of fourteen percent (14%). Beginning January 1, 2006, this certificate fee will be adjusted annually by multiplying the base permit fee for the previous year by the average percentage rate for the month of August of the previous year (rounded to the nearest half dollar) which is derived by a fraction, the numerator of which is the Revised Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics for All Consumers for the Rural Service Area #7 statistical area (All Items, Base 1982-84 = 100), (the "CPI"), and the denominator of which is the CPI for the same calendar month of the prior year. Notwithstanding the foregoing, in no event shall the certificate fee be decreased and in no event shall any increase exceed 4% per annum, without formal action by the Air Pollution Control District Board. The annual certificate fees shall be as follows:
