The Emissions Market Assessment Committee (EMAC), an advisory group of academic economists established by the California Air Resources Board, will hold a public meeting on Monday, September 24, 2012. The EMAC will discuss issues related to design and operation of the California Cap-and-Trade market. The meeting format will allow stakeholders to address the EMAC.

ARB established the EMAC through an interagency agreement with the University of California, Berkeley. The EMAC will provide expert analysis and advice to ARB through quarterly meetings and regular consultations with staff. At least two quarterly meetings per year will be open to the public. In earlier communications with stakeholders ARB staff had originally referred to this group as the "Market Surveillance Committee."

This meeting is intended to provide a forum for discussion between the EMAC members and interested stakeholders. The meeting will be webcast. Stakeholders may also submit questions to the EMAC during the meeting through e-mail.
