Dear Sir/Madam:

This is to invite your participation at a public workshop to discuss a proposed draft Airborne Toxic Control Measure (ATCM) for hexavalent chromium and cadmium emissions from motor vehicle and mobile equipment coatings. This proposed draft ATCM is being developed in response to a request from the California Air Pollution Control Officers Association's Toxics Committee. The proposed ATCM is scheduled for the Air Resources Board's consideration in September 2001.

The proposed draft ATCM would eliminate two toxic air contaminants, hexavalent chromium and cadmium, from motor vehicle and mobile equipment coatings. The proposed draft ATCM would also decrease emissions of lead, another toxic air contaminant. By eliminating or reducing these toxic air contaminants in the coatings, this control measure would reduce public risk regardless of where the coatings are used.

Staff believes the proposed draft ATCM is technically and commercially feasible since manufacturers have offered coatings that exclude these toxic compounds for several years. For example, the South Coast Air Quality Management District prohibited the use of hexavalent chromium and cadmium in these coatings in 1994.
