Our last workshop to discuss proposed regulatory language for TRUs was held on June 5, 2003. Since that time, we held a TRU Workgroup teleconference on July 22, 2003, to discuss recent changes to the draft ATCM, changes to the emissions inventory, potential health risks, and ATCM cost-effectiveness. We have since revised the draft ATCM language and will share our revised regulatory language with you at the October 8th workshop. We will also discuss cost for complying with the ATCM.
