The California Air Resources Board (ARB) staff invites you to participate in a public workshop on November 19, 2002, to discuss possible regulatory approaches to reduce diesel particulate matter (PM) emissions from stationary diesel-fueled engines. At the workshop, we will focus on proposed regulatory language for Airborne Toxic Control Measures (ATCMs) for new and in-use stationary diesel-fueled engines. We will also share with you preliminary concepts for addressing stationary diesel-fueled engines under the Assembly Bill (AB) 2588 "Hot Spots" program.
