DIESEL FUEL ENFORCEMENT

During October and November 1993, the Air Resources Board (ARB) will direct its diesel fuel enforcement efforts at refineries and terminals. We recognize that some end-users and retailers have been unable to turn their tanks to fully complying diesel fuel by October 1. Because of this, end-users and retailers who have noncomplying fuel on-hand on October 1 will not be subject to enforcement action for the use or sale of that fuel after October 1 *as long as the diesel fuel on-hand was legal prior to October 1.*

All motor vehicle diesel fuel delivered to end-users and retailers after September 30 must comply with ARB requirements. Delivery of complying diesel fuel to an end-user or retailer is not a violation of the ARB regulations, whether or not the diesel fuel already on-hand meets the ARB standards.
