Lead in Gasoline Regulations

The purpose of this advisory is to remind you of the upcoming changes in the amount of lead allowed in gasoline.

Legal Requirements

Section 2253.2 of Title 13 of the California Administrative Code regulates the amount of lead in gasoline. Paragraph (c) requires reporting of individual batches under certain circumstances. Paragraph (d) limits the amount of lead which may be used during a calendar quarter.

Changes

Paragraph (c)

On October 1, 1984, the amount of lead in a batch of gasoline which will trigger these reporting requirements will be reduced to 1.0 gram per gallon (g/gal) for leaded high octane gasoline and 0.80 g/gal for leaded gasoline other than leaded high octane gasoline.

Paragraph (d)

On October 1, 1984 the calendar quarter average lead content will be reduced to 0.8 g/gal.
