EXECUTIVE ORDER A-4-65-2  
Relating to Certification of New Motor Vehicle Engines

INTERNATIONAL HARVESTER COMPANY

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Air Resources Board by Sections 43100, 43102, and 43103 of the Health and Safety Code; and

Pursuant to the authority vested in the undersigned by Sections 39515 and 39516 of the Health and Safety Code and Executive Order G-45-3;

IT IS ORDERED AND RESOLVED: That the following International Harvester Company 1979 model-year diesel engines are certified for use in motor vehicles with a manufacturer's gross vehicle weight rating greater than 8500 pounds:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Displacement Cubic Inches</u>	<u>Exhaust Emission Control Systems (Special Features)</u>
DT-466B	466.4	(Turbocharged)
DTI466B	466.4	(Turbocharged, Intercooled)

Engine Models and Codes as listed on attachments.

Section 43200, Part 5, Division 26 of the California Health and Safety Code requires that the engine manufacturer furnish a decal with each engine sold or delivered to a vehicle manufacturer. The decal shall display the applicable model year heavy-duty engine exhaust emission standards and the following certification emission values:

<u>Engine Family</u>	<u>Hydrocarbons gm/bhp-hr</u>	<u>Carbon Monoxide gm/bhp-hr</u>	<u>Nitrogen Oxides gm/bhp-hr</u>
DT466B	0.8	2	6.8
DTI466B	0.7	1	6.5

Engines certified under this Executive Order must conform to all applicable California emission regulations.
