The Air Resources Board (ARB or Board) is submitting the Report on Reductions Achieved from Incentive-Based Emission Reduction Measures in the San Joaquin Valley (Report) to U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) for inclusion in the California State Implementation Plan (SIP). ARB approved the Report at a public hearing on October 24, 2014.

The Report focuses on the Carl Moyer and Proposition 1B incentive program projects and their associated emission reductions in the San Joaquin Valley in 2014. It documents how the included Carl Moyer and Proposition 1B projects fulfill U.S. EPA's SIP creditable requirements of being enforceable, quantifiable, surplus, and permanent.
