Dear Mr. Blumenfeld:

The Air Resources Board (ARB) is submitting to the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) the 2013 San Joaquin Valley State Implementation Plan (Plan) for 1-hour ozone. This submittal also includes a demonstration that growth of emissions from growth of vehicle miles traveled is offset as required by the Clean Air Act section 182 (d) (1) for both the 1-hour and the 8-hour ozone standard. The San Joaquin Valley District (District) adopted the Plan on September 19, 2013 and transmitted it to ARB on September 25, 2013. ARB approved the Plan on November 21, 2013 as a revision to the California State Implementation Plan (SIP) for the San Joaquin Valley.
