Proposed Definitions for Cargo Handling Equipment Regulation

Cargo Handling Equipment:

Off-road vehicle used to lift or move container, bulk, or liquid cargo carried by ship, train, or another vehicle, within an intermodal facility. Equipment includes but is not limited to cranes, yard tractors, top handlers, side handlers, forklifts, loaders, sweepers, excavators, reach stackers, and dozers.

Intermodal Facility:

Any facility used in the movement of cargo by more than one means of conveyance, such as ship to truck, ship to rail, rail to truck, etc.

OR

Any facility used in the loading and unloading of rail cars or ships.
