Project Description:	The proposed amendments correct drafting errors in the " <i>California</i> <i>Procedures for Evaluation Alternative Specifications for Phase 3</i> <i>Reformulated Gasoline Using the California Predictive Model</i> ", delete outdated regulatory provisions, amend the notification requirements for test-certified alternative gasoline formulations, and amend the restrictions on blending California reformulated gasoline blendstock for oxygenate blending (or "CARBOB") with other liquids. Amendments are also being proposed to increase the flexibility, enforceability, and consistency of the regulations.
