<b>Summary:</b> Staff will present for Board consideration a new proposed Low Carbon Fuel Standard (LCFS) regulation that includes revisions to the current regulation, including revised compliance curves, a cost containment provision, crude oil and refinery provisions, revised indirect land use change values, and various other enhancements to the existing LCFS regulation. The Board approved the LCFS on April 23, 2009, and approved amendments on December 16, 2011; however, because of a court ruling that found deficiencies related to the California Environmental Quality Act and the Administrative Procedures Act, the Board must set aside the existing regulation and will consider re-adoption of the LCFS with the proposed revisions.
