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**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THIS FORM**

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**Equipment Failure Information**

Please submit documentation describing the equipment failure. Acceptable equipment failure documentation should include a repair order, or diagnosis, from either:

1. An engine/equipment repair establishment, or
2. An in-house mechanic: To supplement documentation from an in-house mechanic, it is recommended to also submit a depreciation record or a sales/purchase receipt for the replacement engine/equipment unit.

Note: A new application for initial registration is required for replacement engines/equipment units if written notification was not submitted within 30 calendar days of replacing the registered engine/equipment unit.

**Replacement Equipment Information**

Please download the latest engine, pile driver, and equipment unit forms at <https://ww2.arb.ca.gov/resources/documents/perp-application-record-keeping-reporting-forms>.

Note: An identical replacement is appropriate only for cases of equipment failure of an engine or equipment unit. Once an engine has been replaced, it may only re-enter PERP with a new application for initial registration. It must meet eligibility requirements at the time of the application.
