### Check your spot removers!

*Chlorinated solvents in spot removers prohibited since 2013*

#### Did you know:

- Spot removers are prohibited from containing **trichloroethylene, perchloroethylene, methylene chloride** and any chemical compound that has a global warming potential (GWP) value of 150 or greater\*
- Aerosol spot removers may not contain more than 15% by weight volatile organic compounds (VOC)
- Non-aerosol spot removers may not contain more than 3% by weight VOC

\*Unless manufactured before 12/31/12, they may be sold, supplied, or offered for sale until 12/31/15, if properly dated.
