

Instructions for Upgrading HARP to Version 1.2

Step 1

Download and install HARP August 2005 Cumulative Update (harpupdate082005.exe). This file will upgrade your version of HARP to version 1.2.



Step 2

When you first open HARP with the latest patch installed, you will receive two messages informing you that the pollutant and health table are inconsistent with each other. HARP is comparing your pollutant table with the pollutant IDs in the health database.




Click "Ok" on each message box to continue. A message will now appear informing you that a new database format is available.



Click "Yes" to access the data transfer utility


The data transfer utility can also be opened by clicking on Utilities\Upgrades\Upgrade Database.

If your database format is earlier than 210300, HARP will take you through additional steps before upgrading to the latest format.



The database transfer utility will transfer your database to a new database. By default, HARP will add the extension “_082005” at the end of the destination file. The destination filename and file path can be changed using the browse button or textbox. Please make sure the file path exists and contains no spaces.

Click the “Transfer Data” button to begin transferring the data over to a new database. When the data transfer is complete, a message box will appear with the new database filename and path.



To open the new database, select Edit Data\Open Database from the HARP main menu.
