Dear Mr. Nesbit:

The Air Resources Board (ARB) has received all Agency approvals and the State Water Resources Control Board's (State Water Board) determination for your request to amend the Phase II ORVR Compatible VaporVac/Vaporsaver System, Executive Order G-70-204. The amendments requested included the following:

- Use of aluminum as a fan material in place of plastic;
- Addition of a fan support bracket; and
- Use of cast aluminum for five components in place of machined aluminum housings.

Based upon the information previously provided by OPW, submittal of all Agency approvals, and submittal of the State Water Board's determination, ARB staff has determined that the above requests, when installed in accordance with the manufacturer's installation and maintenance instructions, will not adversely affect the performance of the vapor recovery system. ARB staff has also determined that the above requests will not require a revision to Executive Order G-70-204 series.
